



# TRRP ALERT

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Please be advised that the TRRP 13 guidance for Review and Reporting of COC Concentration Data was updated and posted in May 2010. A link to the current document is below:

While there are no major changes to the manner in which data will be delivered to you, we wanted to make you aware that there will be some changes to what you will see in your analytical reports.

Specifically, the results of the Detectability Check Sample (DCS) analyses will now be included in your analytical reports. While your analytical reports currently include a flag to indicate those analytes reported to the DCS, a full list of DCS analyses will now be included as part of the QA/QC section of your analytical report. Also, any analyses which are requested, and for which the TCEQ does not provide NELAC certification, will now be flagged as such.
